The steps described below are the same for students attending both Catholic and non-Catholic schools.



SPEND THE DAY AT TRINITY

APPLY FOR FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

The FACTS Grant and Aid "early" application may be completed only by families with an incoming ninth grader. A link to this online application can be found at www.ths.org/Admissions. The application must be completed by November 12, 2021 in order to be considered for financial assistance from Trinity. Assistance is awarded based on a variety of factors, including demonstrated financial need.

SUBMIT TWO RECOMMENDATION FORMS

Non-Catholic School Students Only In December, download two recommendation forms from www.ths.org/Admissions. These forms should be completed by a 7th or 8th grade teacher, guidance counselor, or school principal on your behalf. Recommendations are due to Trinity's Admissions Office no later than January 24.



APPLY TO TRINITY!

Catholic School Students

The High School Application process begins the first two weeks in January. You will receive a Diocese of Cleveland application from your grade school or if you grade school has opted in to do the online application you will be given instructions on how to complete that process. along with further instructions. Your application and transcripts will be sent to your first choice high school for review. High schools will send decision notices to applicants no earlier than February 10.

**Your second choice high school will see your application only if you are not accepted by your first choice school, or if you ask your first choice school to withdraw your application and send it to your second choice school.

Non-Catholic School Students

In January, download Trinity's Application for Admission from www.ths.org/Admissions. Then, request your transcripts from your grade school. A transcript request form is included with the Application for Admission. Your application, transcripts, and two recommendation forms must be submitted to Trinity's Admissions Office by Monday, January 24. Trinity will send decision notices to applicants no earlier than February 10.
